



RED BARONS RC FLYING CLUB, INC BYLAWS

Effective February 17, 2012

All AMA Rules and Regulations in effect at the time are applicable at this field

Section A: Flying rules

1. All transmitters except those operating on 2.4 GHz must be kept in the impound area when not in use.
2. Engines noise may not exceed AMA maximum sound level requirements.
3. Alcohol or controlled substances are not allowed at the field.

Section B: General club rules.

Guest privileges are limited to no more than three (3) times per year per guest. Host member is responsible for the actions of their guest.

1. All pilots must have current AMA card.
2. Club monetary accounts will be audited at the end of each calendar year
3. All members who are new to the club must demonstrate their ability to take off and land safely.

Section C: Membership fees.

1. Annual dues will be set by the membership at the September meeting for the coming fiscal year.
2. With AMA card, membership for youths under nineteen years of age will be free for that calendar year. After the September meeting the youth membership shall include the following year.
3. Membership roster will be posted February 1st on the web. All dues are payable on or before December 31. Membership chairman will send every current year member a renewal notice unless otherwise requested.
4. Dues paid after June 30 shall be 50% of the annual dues. Dues paid after the September meeting shall apply for the coming year and the remainder of the calendar year.

Section E: Amphitheater flying site safety rules.

1. Except for entering and leaving, the Red Barons' entrance gate will be locked at all times. Our entrance gate is the southernmost gate secured with a combination lock.
2. Flying outside the designated flying area is not permitted. See the posted map at the field. All take offs and landings must be made from the runway in a North/South pattern.
3. No flying on days the amphitheater has scheduled for events. Refer to the Red Barons' website for the Amphitheater schedule.
4. All engines and motors must be started at the north or south end of the pit area. Run-ups in the pits are prohibited.
5. Turbine powered airplanes are prohibited.
6. All internal combustion engines must be less than 40 cc in displacement.
